Hold parent-teacher conferences during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement. Specifically, those conferences will be held:

Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress.

Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:

Daily: assignments will be written in the student's agenda book.

Weekly: Progress reports will go home weekly.

Interim: Mid nine week progress reports

Quarterly report cards: one per each nine week period

Student progress can also be monitored by accessing the Pinnacle Parent Program, which can be monitored via the internet.

Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:

Teachers have daily regular conference times available for scheduling for parent conferences.

Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as follows:

The parent volunteer tutoring program, "Helping Hands", information can be obtained from the Intermediate counselors.

Teacher led programs where the parent speaks to the class sharing information about their careers.
